Chespa Sp. z o.o. hereby announces that, having regard to the protection of human health, the environment and safe use, meets the requirements of the following documents:

1. Regulation EC No <u>1935/2004</u> of the European Parliament and the Council of 27 October 2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and

Commission Regulation EC No <u>2023/2006</u> of 22 December 2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food:

Raw materials used in the manufacture of paints and adhesives are selected in accordance with the principles of GMP (Good Manufacturing Practice) for the manufacture of printing inks for packaging, the products comply with the requirements of Regulation for finished products to print on food packaging, provided the proper use and appropriate packaging design, to prevent direct contact with the printed page packed product.

2. Directive No <u>94/62/EC</u> of the European Parliament and the Council of 20 December 1994 on packaging and packaging waste:

Based on survey the sum Σ metals Pb, Cd, Hg, Cr (VI) does not exceed 100 ppm.

3. Resolution of Council of Europe <u>ResAP(89)1</u> concerning the use of pigments in plastics intended for contact with food:

Based on the survey and the declaration of our suppliers, raw materials for inks and adhesives are all below specified heavy metals and aromatic amines. Phthalates aren't used in the production process.

4. Regulation of the Swiss Confederation Federal States of EDI on consumer goods (food and consumer goods) SR 817.023.21 (update 01/05/2017):

Based on knowledge of the raw materials used to manufacture inks of company Chespa Sp. z o. o., we can confirm that inks are comply with Annex 10 the regulation (SR 817.023.21) of 23rd November 2005 (update of 01 May 2017). The series includes substances listed in the Regulation with an SML migration limit (see table below).

5. Exclusion List of the European Printing Ink Association (EuPIA – November 2016) and Resolution <u>ResAP(2005)2</u> concerning the ink used to print packaging materials and articles intended to come into contact with food:

Products intended for printing food packaging do not contain raw materials excluded because of classification or detailed description on the list. Specifically excluded are all materials classified as toxic or very toxic (including carcinogenic, mutagenic or toxic to reproduction) in accordance with the list of dangerous substances EC Regulation No. 1907/2006 (REACH). As raw materials bought by us are produced under industrial conditions the presence of trace quantities of impurities cannot be excluded.
